SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board to be found at the SailON facebook page.

3 SCHEDULE OF RACES

3.1 Events will take place almost every second Sunday of the month (*: exception - third Sunday)

15/02 *	12/07
08/03	09/08
12/04	20/09 *
10/05	11/10
21/06 *	08/11

3.2 Number of races: maximum 4 per day (target: 3 per day)

3.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day will around 13.30hrs.

3.5 No warning signal will be made after 16.00hrs.

4 CLASS FLAGS

Class flags will be an international flag.

5 THE COURSES

5.1 The diagrams in Attachment A show the courses.

6 MARKS

6.1 Marks are described in Attachment A.

7 THE START

7.1 Races will be started by using rule 26 with the warning signal made 5 minutes before the starting signal.

7.2 The starting line will be between staffs displaying orange flags on the starting marks.

8 THE FINISH

8.1 The finishing line will be between staffs displaying orange flags on the finishing marks.

9 TIME LIMITS AND TARGET TIMES

9.1 Time limits and target times are as follows: target time 20 minutes

9.2 Boats failing to finish within 10 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish without a hearing.

10 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

10.1 Protest will be treated according the ‘Goofies’ principle.

12 SCORING

12.1 The scoring system is as follows: High point system.

Each participant will receive 10 points when participating a race.

Place one to ten will be awarded with points equal to 11 minus their position.

12.2 A minimum 10 races are required to be completed to constitute a series. No more than 30 races will be completed.

13.3 For every serie of five races that has been completed one discard will be taken into account.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

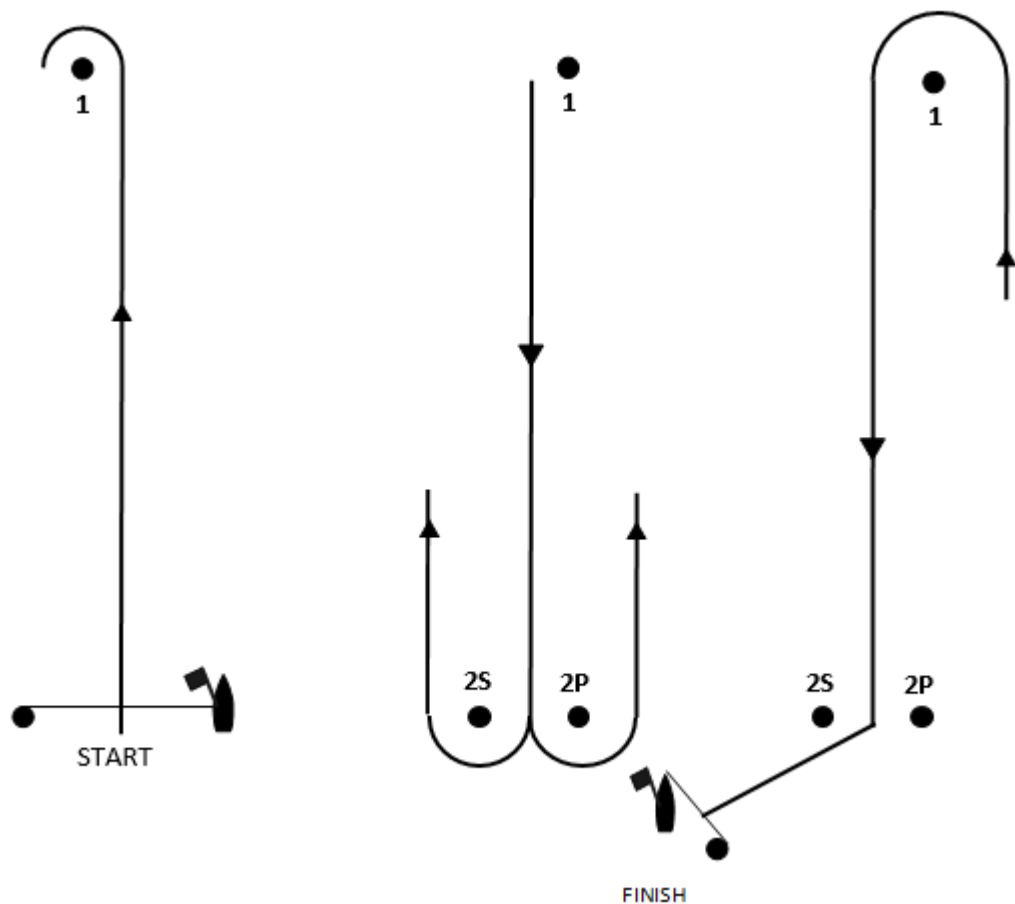
